

 - Provide a competitive market advantage



WHAT DOES THIS ALL MEAN \$555

- Data analytics prior to Power BI was
 - Costly
 - Only available to the Fortune 500
 - Needed programming language
- Data analytics after Power BI
 - Inexpensive
 - Available to everyone
 - DAX is the underlying language (fairly easy to learn)

WHAT DO I NEED

- Computer
- Power BI desktop
- Data sources
 - Sequel Server (Jonas Data Mining)
 - Excel
 - Any other source of data that is meaningful
- Optional items
 - Power BI Pro (\$9.99 monthly per user)
